Rostering Procedures

- ▶ Rosters for all competitions will be closed during the Close Season.
- ▶ On July 07th 2026 ,Team entries for SWWGL closes.
- ▶ On July 7th 2026 Rostering of teams will begin. The Parent level rosters will be open for clubs to self roster players, into the correct Competition/ age group/team.
- ▶ On 23rd August Self Rostering will cease and by this time all clubs must have rostered at least the minimum amount, of players stated in the SWWGL rules. all Rosters will now be closed. From this point on, any Rostering of players, or internal movement of players , will be carried out via email request from the Club Secretary only , to the Roster Officer at rosters@swwgl.co.uk
- ▶ What should be in your email; Players Full Name, Comet ID, DOB, State Internal/ External transfer or New Player, Name of Team to ADD Player, Age Group & Division. During Season - Emails must be sent by 8pm on the Friday before the Sunday for the play to appropriately be added to the squad.
- ▶ Any other method of contact will NOT be accepted.



Guidelines To Roster A Team

- ▶ 1. Go to My Competitions on Comet . Select Competition .
- ▶ 2 You will see the name of the Competition you have selected. Under this heading will be PARENT COMPETITION and CLUBS. Select CLUBS.
- ▶ 3 A list of all clubs in the competition will appear. Find your team and Click on the + sign in the red box. This will open up a list of all registered players who are eligible to play in this competition.
- ▶ 4 Select the players you wish to place in this team and click on Add players at the bottom of the page. You can check your player selected list by clicking on the arrowhead on the left side of the original screen.
- ▶ 5 If you have more than one team in the age group, (Seniors Exc) , you cannot have the same players in both teams.
- ▶ 6. Following closure of Rosters, prior to Season start, all rostering and internal transfers etc. carried out by the club, stops. (see above).
- ▶ 7 Any new rostering or internal transfers , will NOT be allowed on Match Day. Notification of desire to roster a new registration, Internal transfer etc , must be received, via the correct method of communication , by 8p.m on the Friday prior to the Sunday Match. Any requests coming in after this deadline will be dealt with before the next fixture involving the team.
- ▶ In the case of midweek games , notification must be received by 6 p.m of the day prior to Match day.
- ▶ 8. Internal transfers, player or Goalkeeper, will only be allowed if permission has been granted by the League.
- ▶ 9. Special dispensation for players will only be allowed with permission from League.
- ▶ 10. When Player Registrations cease in March, the Rostering and Internal Transfers, of Players and Goalkeepers will also cease.
- ▶ Rule 4.1.3 Annex 1 - Any teams without sufficient number of players Rostered to it, by 7 days prior to Kick off, will not be allowed to play first and subsequent fixtures, until Minimum number of players is reached. In each case a charge of Failure To Play will be sent to the offending club for each instance. If this occurs 3 times the team will be removed from the League.
- ▶ Squad sizes are capped at 20. U12 to u17 teams.
- ▶ Mini Football U11 and down are not governed by all the above guideline/rules.



Guidelines To Remove A Player From Roster

- ▶ Although the movement and addition of players, is closed to the clubs as soon as the season starts, the removal players from a club's roster will still be the responsibility of the Club Secretary.
- ▶ 1 Go to Competition page as above
- ▶ 2 select your team.
- ▶ 3 Click on > to the left of your team, a list of your rostered players appear.
- ▶ 4 If a player has left your club, and has not played a game, you can Terminate the player. If she has played you make her Inactive, by pressing relevant Red box.
- ▶ In either case, you Must make her Inactive, if not the player will remain showing as a squad member.





FIXTURE CHANGES

HOW TO REQUEST?



ALL COMPETITIVE FIXTURES WILL USE COMET FOR FIXTURE UPDATES AND COMMUNICATIONS.



▶ HOW TO REQUEST FIXTURE CHANGES

Clubs must complete all sections of Fixture Changes form when requesting fixture changes. Forms that are incomplete will be returned for completion. This ensures that all necessary information is received the first time, preventing delays and ensuring we maintain accurate records for the League Management Committee if needed. This must be completed 5 days prior to the game commencing i.e. **Tuesday** and sent to the relevant fixture secretary. (Form will be sent prior to the start of the season).



For fixture change requests – please see forms on **SWWGL.co.uk** – go to **Fixture Secretaries** tab and find correct age group.



▶ FIXTURE RULE 5.1.1

All fixtures arranged by the league must be communicated to the participating clubs with a minimum of **7 days' notice** before the scheduled match date. Cup dates will be three days. Any changes to fixture details, such as pitch, time, or venue, must be updated in the **Comet** system no later than the 5 Days i.e. **Tuesday** preceding the match. Failure to do so may result in fines.

Please see Annexe 1. In emergencies (frozen pitch /waterlogged changing to 3 g 3), fixture changes may be allowed up to two hours before the scheduled kick-off, provided the LMC agrees and all relevant parties are promptly notified.



▶ LEAGUE GAMES

Please do not expect multiple gaps throughout the season, as this can create difficulties when fixtures need to be rearranged. Fixture Secretary may bring fixtures forward when possible, providing clubs with a minimum of 7 days' notice for league games and 3 days notice for Cup Games. However, from March to May, there may be occasions where less than 7 days' notice is given to ensure the league can be completed on time.

(Season Ends 31st May, please don't expect a Free Week).

IMPORTANT REMINDERS



NO REFEREE BY TUESDAY?

If no referee is assigned by Tuesday before the fixture, the home club should assist in searching for a referee and notify the Referee Coordinator immediately if successful.



IMPARTIALITY

Clubs should avoid using the same referee for the same home team repeatedly to maintain impartiality.



FIXTURE CANCELLED?

If a fixture is cancelled, clubs must inform the appropriate Fixture Secretary immediately so COMET can be updated and unnecessary travel costs avoided.
